Literacy:	Comprehension: We will read a range of books together, including wordless texts. We will talk about, sequence and retell the stories we have read. Word Reading: We will begin to learn the 'Sounds-Write Initial Code' (Unit 1: a, i, m, s, t, Unit 2: n,p,o, Unit 3: b,c,g,h); listening for and practising writing the sounds in simple CVC words. Writing: We will practise writing our names with all the letters correctly formed. We will begin to use our Phonetic knowledge to spell words and label images.
