GOOGLE MEET

What do my teachers expect from me on Google Meet?

During this academic year, there may be some periods of time where we need to spend some time apart from one another. This is to keep you, your teachers and your families safe.

To make sure that we can all keep in contact with one another, we are going to start to use Google Meet through your Google Classroom account. Google Meet is a really useful tool that will let you see your teacher and hear their voice and get to participate in some online lessons. This will help us to help you to continue to make the amazing progress that you make when you are in school with us!

To make sure that we keep everyone safe when we are online we need your help!

Below we have listed some St. John Bosco rules which we expect you to follow when interacting with Google Meet. Your teachers and parents may talk to you about this so that you have a really good understanding of what you need to do ready for your next online session. Make sure you follow these rules really carefully when you are online to keep everyone safe.

1. Be prepared, have your login to the meet ready and at the right time. (Your teachers will tell you this information when they share the meet link)
2. Sit in a quiet public place in your home, for example your kitchen or living room, do not use meet in your bedroom.
3. Blur your background on the screen
4. Try to stay in one spot during the video call.
5. Mute your microphone until the teacher asks you to unmute when everyone is ready
6. Try to focus when the teacher is talking, turn off all potential distractions. It is a new way of working for all of us but we will get used to it, so be patient.
7. Be polite and respectful to your teachers and friends; remember you may need to wait for your turn to speak.
8. Do not try to record or screen shot the google meet session, this will result from you being removed from the online session.
9. Be the best you can be, show your excellent manners, put your hand up and try your best, we look forward to working this way while we cannot all be together.



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
